



2012 Bronco Division Information

For the Spring 2012 season, MBA will once again be offering two levels of competition for Bronco players. We will compete in the 680 Diablo League with one 12U team (11 year olds are eligible), and we will have 3-5 teams compete in the Morindamont league against Orinda and Piedmont teams.

The Bronco 680 12U Diablo League is highly competitive and requires an elevated level of commitment from participating players. Players are expected to make a full commitment to 12U team practices and games from February through early June. The 12U Bronco 680 Team Manager will be a paid coaching position. There will be an additional fee to participate on this team.

Evaluations for the Moraga Bronco Morindamont teams will be at Joaquin Moraga School on Saturday, January 7th from 9am - 1pm. Players will be asked to participate in one of four 60-90 minute evaluation sessions. MBA will post the times for specific player evaluations the week before January 7th.

Evaluations for the Moraga Bronco 680 Diablo League team are scheduled for Saturday, January 7th from 3-5pm and Sunday, January 8th from 3-5pm, also at Joaquin Moraga School. These evaluations will be separate and in addition to the Bronco league tryouts on Saturday morning, January 7th. Team formation will be made within 2 weeks of evaluations. The January evaluation along with manager/coach feedback from last spring's season will be used to help determine the team.
